Setting **SMART** Budget Expectations To Fix It Right

What range of budget are you open to investing IF you know it will accomplish your goals & fix the problems? Some people expect a quick fix. Reality is the work needed to fix it right is often much more than expected.

To fix it right, project costs range: \$7,000 - \$15,000 per 1,000 sq ft of house footprint.

Select a design budget per 1,000 sq ft of house FOOTPRINT:

- \$2,500 - \$5,000 per 1,000 sq ft (selling the home, don't care about results)
- \$5,000 - \$10,000 per 1,000 sq ft (fix most of the problems)
- \$10,000 - \$15,000 per 1,000 sq ft (full transformation, great results)
- \$15,000+ per 1,000 sq ft (whatever it takes to fix it right)

What is the house footprint?

If your 1,000 sq ft house is a single-story slab house, the footprint is 1,000 sq ft. A 2 story slab house with a 500 sq ft first floor and 500 sq ft second floor is probably a 500 sq ft footprint. If you have a 1,000 sq ft pier-and-beam house with an attic and crawlspace, then you have a 1,000 sq ft footprint in both the attic & crawlspace.

Why is the lowest price category \$2,500?
